

## Who is Mary Earps?

Mary Earps is a professional footballer who was born on the 7<sup>th</sup> March 1993. She currently plays for Manchester United, where she is their goalkeeper in the WSL (Women's Super League). In addition to this, she has played internationally as part of the England squad. She decided she wanted to become a professional footballer when she was playing football in the garden with her dad and brother as a child.

#### What has Mary achieved?

In her senior career, Earps worked hard to become the number 1 goalkeeper for England. In the summer of 2022, Mary was part of the England squad that won the Euros. She was also named Best FIFA Women's goalkeeper in the same year. In 2023, Mary was the  $1^{st}$  female player to reach her 50<sup>th</sup> clean sheet, Manchester United's player of the month and made it to the finals of the Women's World Cup where she won the Golden Glove award.
